



Grupo Energía Bogotá ranks among the top global companies for its community relations, according to the Dow Jones Sustainability index.

- For the eighth consecutive year, Grupo Energía Bogotá (GEB) consolidated its position in this index, which is a benchmark for companies and investors from around the world in managing sustainability under environmental, social and corporate governance criteria.
- This recognition given to the Group is noteworthy as it creates value for the Company because of its stakeholder engagement practices, as well as contributions in the area of human rights.

Grupo Energía Bogotá leads the Dow Jones Sustainability Index in the emerging markets category (Western Europe, India, China, South Africa and Central and South America), with the best performance in the gas sector, above companies like Japan's Osaka Gas Co. Ltd., Italy's Italgas SpA, India's GAIL Ltd., and Mexico's Infraestructura Energética Nova, coming in second place after Spain's Naturgy Energy Group.

For the eighth consecutive year, GEB strengthened its ranking in the index, ratifying its commitment to create shared value and positioning itself as the Colombian energy sector company with the best track record in the index and the best sustainability practices in the world, taking environmental, social and corporate governance criteria (ESG) into account.

According to assessment results, GEB stands out due to its good stakeholder engagement practices, ability to attract and retain human talent, biodiversity and risk management practices.

The Group attained a rating that placed it in the top 6% of companies in the sector with best corporate sustainability performance, from among all the companies included in the index worldwide.

For Astrid Álvarez, President of Grupo Energía Bogotá, *“this achievement is the result of the Group's commitment to genuine relations with communities in Peru, Colombia and Guatemala, where our main cultural feature is social conscience and contributions to improving the quality of life in the territories where we develop our projects”*.

The Dow Jones is the most internationally renowned sustainability index, which for 20 years it has been assessing the performance of leading companies around the world as regards social, environmental, and corporate governance matters. It was created in 1999, with the aim of recognizing companies with high standards in each of the aforesaid areas, hence the importance of such recognition. Only 10 Colombian companies were listed in this index in 2019 in its different categories.
