



Bogotá D.C., July 29, 2019. Regarding the information published by the *El Tiempo* newspaper on July 19, 2019, and pursuant to the requirement made by the Financial Superintendence of Colombia by means of a communication filed under number 2019101831-000-000, as regards an employee of Contugas SAC (“Contugas”), Mrs. Patricia Diaz Gazzolo, who has been employed at said company since 2014, Grupo Energía Bogotá reports that:

Last July 9, Contugas Board members were informed by the Legal Manager (acting) of Contugas about the preliminary investigation that was initiated against Mrs. Díaz, Manager (acting) of Contugas.

At that time, the corporate governance mechanisms of Contugas were activated, and an extraordinary meeting of Contugas Board’s Audit and Risk Committee was called, which was held that same day. The members of said Committee requested Mrs. Diaz to provide explanations on the matter and to submit a report on the preliminary investigation against her. The report was discussed at the meeting of Contugas Board’s Audit and Risk Committee held on July 12, and the employee reported that she had no connection with the alleged facts of the investigation against her.

In her capacity as Legal Manager of Contugas, Mrs. Diaz will keep the Audit and Risk Committee of the Board continuously informed of the development of the preliminary investigation initiated against her, in order to continuously monitor the situation and to make any relevant decisions.

It is important to highlight that the events reported in the press release published on July 19, 2019 are in no way related to the activities carried out by Contugas or to the activities performed by its employees in fulfillment of their duties.
