

GEB Volunteers renovated the Integrated Protection Unit of San Francisco

Bogotá, D.C., March 31, 2017. Grupo Energía de Bogotá (GEB) and the District Institute for Protection of Childhood and Adolescence (Idipron), worked today on the renovation of the Integrated Protection Unit (UPI) in the municipality of San Francisco in Cundinamarca. The campaign was purported to improve the facilities while delivering arts and sports activities for children and youngsters of Idipron.

This activity was undertaken with the participation of the collaborators that comprise the GEB Volunteering Group, known as *“United with Energy”*. This group has been continuously supporting the Institute in different ludic and entertaining activities intended to bring welfare to children and young people of the area.
