

Grupo Energía de Bogotá protects the archaeologic heritage in Peru

Bogotá D.C., February 2nd, 2017. Cálidda, a company in which Grupo Energía de Bogotá holds a 60% equity interest, is the first private company to take-part in the program "Lima, City of huacas" (Sacred places), sponsored by the Peruvian Ministry of Culture. This program seeks to promote actions geared to protect the Pre-Hispanic archeological monuments, which enclose hundreds of years of history.

During the process, Cálidda will collaborate with the setting of the Sacred Place of Mangomarca, located in San Juan de Lurigancho, and the construction of a cultural center. Both projects will become relevant tourist and cultural attractions for Lima.

This program also seeks engage local governments, private companies and the civil society, to develop initiatives intended to recover the cultural identity alongside the development of the required infrastructure for each city. The program will also coordinate joint activities oriented towards promoting sustainable development.

For Grupo Energía de Bogotá, participating and supporting these initiatives is part of the company's commitment to achieving comprehensive excellence on sustainable development.

Cálidda is part of the companies that Grupo Energía de Bogotá has framed within the strategy of Urban Energy Solutions, focused on developing and operating the infrastructure needed to cater for the demands of electric energy and natural gas in the big cities with high energy consumption.

Currently, Cálidda hols a 33-year concession contract to design, build and operate the distribution system of natural gas in the department of Lima and the Constitutional Province of Callao, which are expected to become a pioneer model for public services in Peru, contributing to improving the quality of life of the population, and the preservation of the environment. Cálidda carries natural gas to more than 2 million Peruvians, 524 big industries, and 225,000 natural gas powered vehicles.
