EEB will participate in the acquisition of 31.92% of TGI

Bogotá, D.C., December 11th 2013. Today, Empresa de Energía de Bogotá's Board of Directors, parent company of Grupo Energía de Bogotá, approved the participation of EEB in the acquisition process of 31.92% stake that Citi Venture Capital International (CVCI) owns in Transportadora de Gas Internacional (TGI), the largest natural gas transportation network in Colombia, in which EEB owns 68.05%, exercising its right established in the shareholders' agreement.

TGI is the largest natural gas transportation company in the country with 47.6% of participation in the market and an infrastructure of pipelines of 3,957 km serving the most populated areas of Colombia as Bogota, Medellin, Bucaramanga, Eje Cafetero and the Piedemonte Llanero.

This decision is part of the investment plan that the company has projected for the next four years. EEB is the parent company of Grupo Energía de Bogotá, a multinational company in the energy sector, which major shareholder is the City of Bogotá. EEB participates throughout the whole electricity chain from generation to commercialization, and transportation and distribution of natural gas, through controlled and non-controlled subsidiaries.

EEB has optimal investment ratings: Local AAA Fitch, BBB – International; Moody's Baa3 and Standard & Poor's BBB-. Likewise, thanks to its diversification of business and internationalization, their share has had one of best performance in the local securities exchange in the last semester.

Moreover, the company is one of the leaders in the Global Compact and the only Colombian company of the fifty-six around the world that comprise the Lead Group of the Global Compact. Also EEB is one of the eight Colombian companies that make part of the Dow Jones sustainability index.

About Grupo Energía de Bogotá

Grupo Energía de Bogotá is one of the leading companies in the Colombian energy sector. Through EEB, it operates the electricity transmission grid for Colombia's largest, and one of its fastest growing, markets. The Group also has the controlling interest in Colombia's largest natural gas carrier, TGI S.A. In Peru, its subsidiary CONTUGAS has a 30-year concession for the transportation and distribution of natural gas in the Ica Department, while CALIDDA distributes natural gas in Lima and Callao. EEB also owns —together with ISA— REP S.A. and TRANSMANTARO S.A., which operate 63% of Peru's electricity grid. In 2010, it incorporated Transportadora de Centroamérica S.A. (TRECESA) which is building the largest energy infrastructure



project in Guatemala, and which is expected to start electricity transmission operations in 2013. EEB also holds significant investments in other large companies in the energy sector, including CODENSA S.A., EMGESA S.A., GAS NATURAL S.A., Empresa de Energía de Cundinamarca (EEC), and Electrificadora del Meta (EMSA), as well as smaller investments in ISA and ISAGEN.

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
