



Grupo Energía Bogotá, through its subsidiary TGI, will build \$8.500 million Public Works for Tax Deduction in the Department of Cesar.

- *This is the first project of Public Works for Tax Deduction in which TGI will contribute with the welfare of the 31.000 inhabitants of the municipality of La Paz.*

Bogotá D.C., Monday, May 20, 2019. TGI, a subsidiary of Grupo Energía Bogotá, was awarded by the National Government with the first Public Works for Tax Deduction project, with an investment amounting to \$ 8.500 million, consisting of the construction and optimization of the Phase I aqueduct system networks in the urban center of the municipality of La Paz, in the department of Cesar.

The project was awarded to TGI on May 13, 2019 by resolution of the National Agency for the Territory Renewal (*Agencia Nacional de Renovación del Territorio*). The construction phase will begin this year with the aim of improving the continuity and coverage conditions in terms of the aqueduct service provision for the 31.000 inhabitants of the municipality. The project comprises the construction of approximately 37 kilometers of 3" -10" polyethylene and ductile iron pipes.

For Astrid Álvarez, president of Grupo Energía Bogotá, *"the award of this project is another step to keep on working for the regions' development where the Group operates in a committed manner. These works result in progress and well-being for the communities, which is a fundamental part of our management"*.

Public Works for Tax Deduction is the National Government program that offers companies the possibility of paying up to 50% of their income tax, through the direct execution of investment projects that take place in the Areas Most Affected by the Armed Conflict (ZOMAC in Spanish). Projects should aim to the construction, improvement, optimization or expansion of infrastructure and the provision required to supply energy services, road infrastructure, drinking water and sewerage, education and public health.

For his part, the (acting) President of TGI, Mauricio Vera, said that *"this first project of Public Works for Tax Deduction in the municipality of La Paz becomes an opportunity for a genuine relationship, one of the main features of companies like TGI, which are part of Grupo Energía Bogotá"*.
