NATURAL GAS TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE EVENT IN COLOMBIA'S COUNTRYSIDE IS FINALLY SOLVED

Bogotá, D.C. Friday, June 22, 2018. Transportadora de Gas Internacional, TGI, informs that repair works carried out in the Cusiana – Miraflores section, located at the Páez Municipality, Boyacá Department, led to the reestablishment of the system' operational conditions and to the normalization of gas transportation to the countryside from the Cusiana and Cupiagua production fields.

The process to normalize services in the sectors that reported any kind of restrictions is being coordinated with distributors, leading to the reestablishment of gas transportation services for the Natural Gas Vehicle sector, first, and the industrial sector, a few hours later.

We would like to extend our gratitude to the inhabitants and authorities of Páez for their collaboration; to the Governor of the Boyacá Department and Mayor of the Páez Municipality, whose management was instrumental in overcoming this event. Also, is it worth noting the engagement of the National Police, the National Army, the Departmental and Municipal councils for Disaster Risk Management and by all the entities that supported us throughout this event.
